

Society Member Instructions – International Society of Heterocyclic Chemistry

We are pleased to confirm that all current society members have access to *Progress in Heterocyclic Chemistry* online via ScienceDirect. There are just two steps each member needs to take to ensure they can access the e-books at any time:

- 1) Firstly, please activate your access by clicking the link in the instructions below (the access is linked to specific email addresses, so this will need to be the same email address you provided to the ISHC)
- 2) Secondly, please register for a ScienceDirect account using the same email address (if you already have a Science Direct account using that email address, you do not need to register again)

Once those two steps are complete, you will be able to access the books by going to <http://www.sciencedirect.com/science/journal/09596380> or **using the link on the ISHC web site** and logging in using your science direct login details.
